ACTIVITY/IES-

- 2) Continue to review and reinforce EXPLICIT SOP routines for your classroom, hallway, bathroom etc. (students should know HOW TO and APPLY standard operating procedures for just about everything)
- 3) Work on smiling at each other, morning greetings, etc. Talk about the POWER of a smile.
